Application procedure:

1. Fill in the information on your name, address, phone, birth date and email.
2. Fill in the grade at which your **continuous KPS enrollment and residency began**.
 - 2.1. Enrollment must have started by the fall state census date (usually prior to October 1) of school for that grade.
 - 2.2. Enrollment must have been in a KPS district school or approved program (authorized by KPS, but not offered by a KPS school).
 - 2.3. See The Kalamazoo Promise website (www.kalamazoopromise.com) for clarifications on this requirement, under frequently asked questions (FAQ) or your school counselor for a paper copy of the same.
 - 2.4. You must have resided within the KPS enrollment district during this entire enrollment period.
3. Fill in your expected graduation date and high school.
4. List supported college or university(s) to which you have applied or plan to apply. List your choices in order of preference, you only are required to list one. These must be a state supported public community college, college, or university. (see list below)
5. Sign the form. If you are not at least 18 years of age your parent or guardian must **ALSO** sign and provide their contact information if different from yours. **All students must sign.**
