## **Higher Promise Program Information and Benefits**

- · College scholars matriculating to junior year, senior year, and who are graduating are prioritized
- Scholars receive resume development and interview preparation support (Fall 2023)
- Students are matched with local business partners, based on majors and career interests (Winter 2024)
- The internship will take place between approximately May 16th and August 19th (exact dates will be determined by company and intern)
- All internships will pay at least \$16 per hour

- Interns participate in a Professional Development course throughout the internship period and will have class bi-weekly Fridays. It will culminate in a final class presentation
- Participants will connect with and develop a peer network of 70+ Promise Scholars
- Networking opportunities through intern mixers
- Students are paired with a mentor to help Scholars grow professionally, and learn about the company and industry
